

SchoolNetwork Bond Search Hints

The SchoolNetwork Logo

Think of the logo as your "Home" button. Regardless of what screen you are viewing, click the logo to load your DASHBOARD (shown on the next page).

The Filters Menu




Fig. 2 Setting Filters

You can set filters for your searches here. (See Fig. 2 below)

The Reset Button

Clicking reset will clear any filters you have set, and run a new search of the database, reverse sorted by the most recently modified/added opportunities..

The User Options Menu






Fig. 3 Managing Alerts and your Default Search

Click here to access your email alerts, and to set your default search. (See Fig. 3 and 4 below)

You can filter for things you want included in your search (and therefore exclude things that don't match your filters.) Then click "**Search**" in the lower right hand corner of the filters dialog to run a filtered search.

Status: SchoolBondFinder tracks all improvement opportunities through four status categories, from "We are just watching this" through "Proposed for vote, Peaced or Failed."

Search: This field searches the text descriptions for each opportunity. Place an "OR" in between terms if you are looking for either/or a specific terms or terms.

State: Choose one or more states if you do not want to search all 50. Choosing one state allows you to choose one or more counties within a state.

District: You can search for the history of a specific district in our system

Maturity Start and End: Financial Service companies may want to know when a district is about to pay off previous bonds \dots and perhaps issue more.

Start Date / End Date for voting: Look for opportunities that are being (or have already been) voted on between set dates.

Min Students / Max Students: Look for districts of a certain size.

Max Bonds: How many results do you want to see at one time? By default, this number is 1500, but you can set it lower or higher. Lower numbers result in faster searches. High numbers give more results, but may take longer.

Categories: Our researchers read through information available for opportunities, and manually assign categories from which you may filter.

Include Historical: This checkbox lets you include Information provided by arrangement with Yale University, dating from 1960-2014. It is provided 'as is' as part of a data set provided for historical purposes only. It does not represent the entirety of school capital expenditure during those years, nor the efforts of the SchoolBondFinder/SchoolNetwork research team.

Clicking "Create Alert" will allow you to set an email alert to link to any changes to the results for a specific search. You may choose the frequency for which you want to receive the emails.

Choosing "Alerts" from the User Options menu will bring up a list of all alerts you have set. From here, you may delete an alert (using the "x" in the upper right hand corner of any box), or re-run an alert search (by clicking on the blue links).

You may also set any one alert as your personal "default" search by clicking on the "star" icon next to an alert. Every time you log in, you will see this search as your first list of results. Click on the star again to turn it off, or select another other to be your default.

NOTE: You may have to logout/login to see the change.

Pursuit of constructing a new building will continue by gathering information on funding possibilities, working with the OFCC, and considering an architect and bond counsel.

New construction of replacement schools for Little Powder Elementary School and Campbell County High School Gorr renovations of Campbell County High School.

The district was meeting with School Facilities Commission in Sept. 2019 to present these capital projects. The district approved a purchase and sale agreement for property for the new Little Powder Elementary school in May 2020. As of Sept. 14, 2021 the construction of a new Little Powder School and demolition of the current Little Powder School are included in the School Facilities Commission 2023-2024 budget, but that could change. No new information as of March 29, 2022.
